The football raffle is our most significant money raiser and allows the Council to significantly contribute and participate in many worthy causes. Last year we sold 1,038 tickets but have sold only 800 so far this year. Those additional 238 tickets could give us almost \$6,000 towards this year's programs.

In selling the tickets, it's important to know that there are seven chances to win every week of the 17 game season. That's 119 chances to win up to \$500. Those are much better odds than the <u>LOTTERY</u>.

The game is over on September 8th, the first Monday night game of the NFL season. Let's make it a win for the Council and our parish.
